

## **James Donlon Boulevard Project Description**

The project is to construct a 1.98-mile roadway extension of James Donlon Boulevard, located in the undeveloped hills south of Pittsburg. The project's limits are from the western edge of Sky Ranch II proposed subdivision to Kirker Pass Road. The bypass will ultimately connect the existing James Donlan Boulevard in Antioch with Kirker Pass Road in unincorporated Contra Costa County. It will provide a critical east-west transportation corridor in East County and congestion relief to existing Buchanan Road, a regional route of significance in the City of Pittsburg. The project is an important component of the Route 4 East Corridor Major Investment Study's (MIS) long-term recommended strategy completed in May 1999. The roadway is also identified in the City of Pittsburg's General Plan, the adopted East County Action Plan (prepared by TRANSPLAN), and CCTA's Comprehensive Transportation Project List. The City of Pittsburg is the lead agency on this regional transportation corridor project.

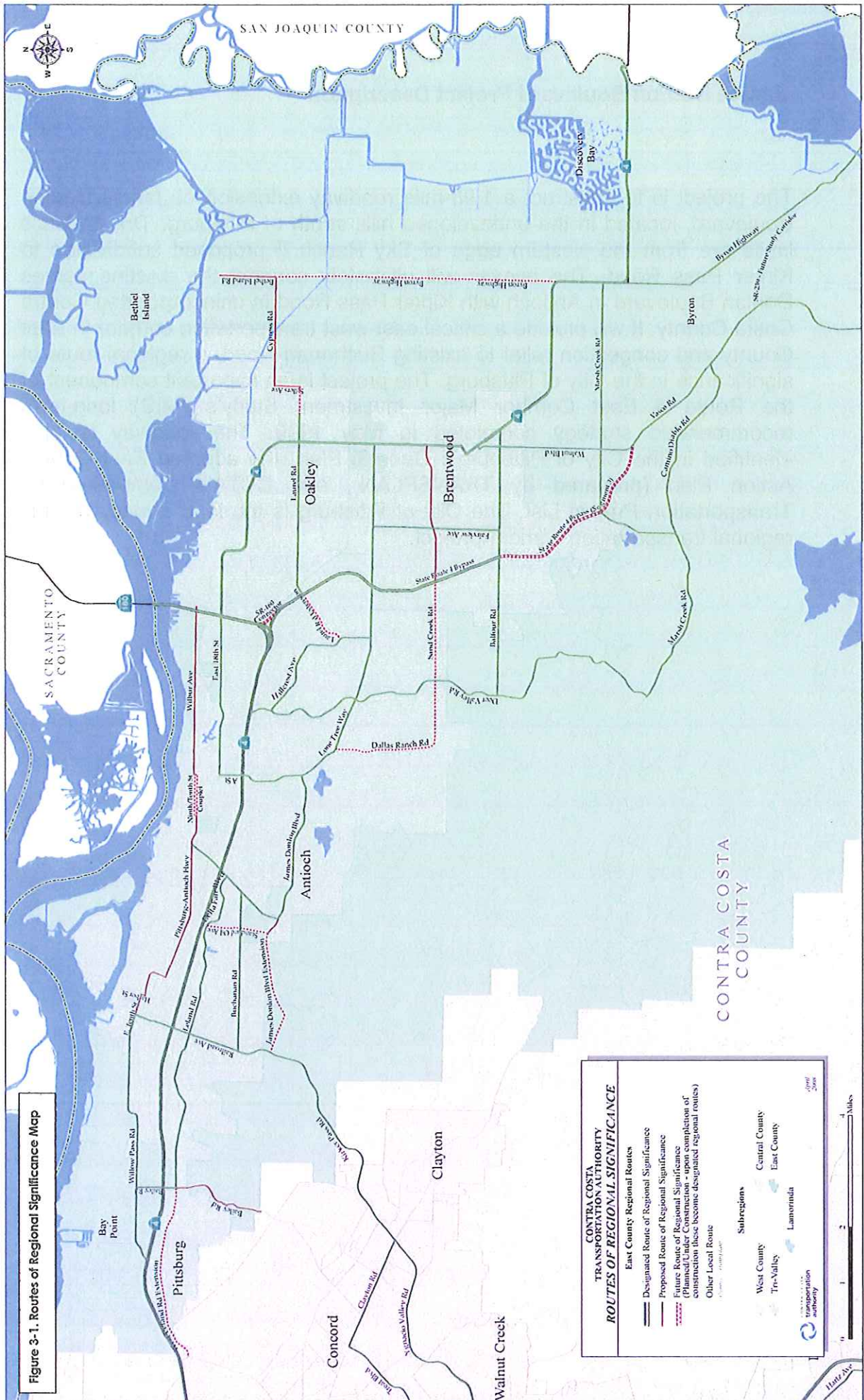


Figure 3-1. Routes of Regional Significance Map
