

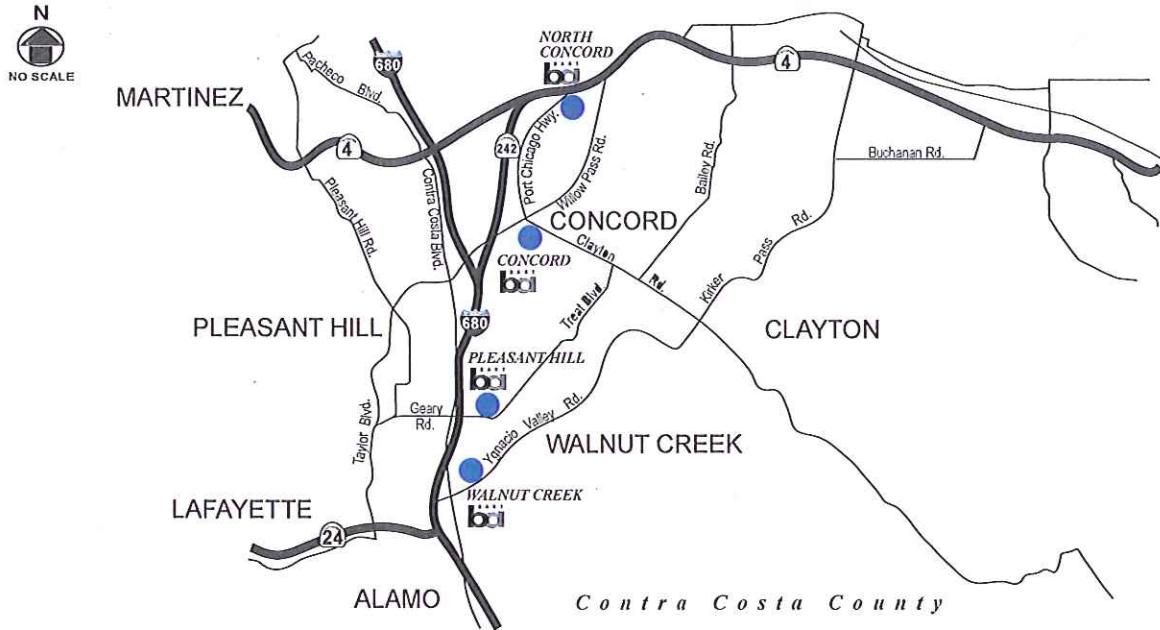

Need/Purpose
