What is Walk N Roll?










A customized encouragement program to encourage active transportation and carpool at elementary schools









What is the program?



All students receive a Scan Tag that affixes to a backpack







How does it work?

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Parents can choose to individualize their student's Scan Tag



You just hit 100 miles!

The Scanning app provides the student with immediate feedback and gives you real time access to data for one school or a whole district.

How it works.

We provide the tools to help implement, encourage and evaluate your active transportation program. Each student is given an id tag that is scanned with our free app on program days. This scan captures the students trip, distance and mode. The optional parent notification (Text, Phone, or Email) can be sent in real-time. The system can grow with your needs from one day a month, to a daily program. Data reports/exports are available at the district, school, classroom and student level.

Every school is unique which is why we've created an assortment of tools you can mix and match to create your perfect program.




2024/25 Summary of Programs at 7 schools to date







How do we start?



- Use the interest survey to send to the school community
- Confirm Walk 'n Roll coordinator
- Sign school agreement by Coordinator, Principal and PTA President
- 5 weeks to launch (Create mascot, printed assets, volunteer training, video production)

Barriers to Starting
